TO BE A CATECHIST – ADULT LEADER OF A CHILDREN’S GROUP

HELPING PLAN AND PREPARE DECORATIONS FOR THE FIRST COMMUNION RECEPTION

You will be part of a committee that plans, prepares and sets up the school hall for the First Communion Reception. You will need to organise decorations and table settings prior to the event. You will need to be available the day before to set up the hall. You will not need to organise children’s food or help out on the actual day.
